CLEAN WATER IN NABYUNYU

Water and sanitation are essential for life and health, but they are also essential for dignity, empowerment, and prosperity. Water and sanitation are human rights, fundamental to every child and adult. But in Uganda, poor sanitation and hygiene and unequal access to safe drinking water makes thousands of children very sick and at risk of death (unicef.org).

Nearly 90 percent of Uganda's 35 million people live in small towns and rural areas, and roughly twothirds of them lack access to safe water. Poor sanitation worsens the problem. Waterborne diseases and infant mortality are widespread. (ifc.org). This is no different in the village of Nabyunyu in Bugiri, Uganda.

Nabyunyu is a rural village with no water access, making clean water expensive and inaccessible to people, making them vulnerable to water-related diseases.

Together, our staff in Uganda has been working with local government officials and village leadership to establish the best site for the well and share its construction timeline and responsibilities with community members.

YOUR LASTING

Like much of Uganda, the water in this district is primarily collected by women and very young children.

This clean water well reduces disease, eliminates the time to access water, and increases productivity at home and in markets. Perhaps the most impacted will be the children who will reduce time to get water and hence spend more time reading and studying and creating a brighter future!

A church committee has been established for the day-to-day management of the water source to ensure the longevity of this well. The district chairman, men, women, and youth will lead this diverse five-member committee. Together, they will be responsible for the use of the water resource and repairing the source in case of a breakdown.
